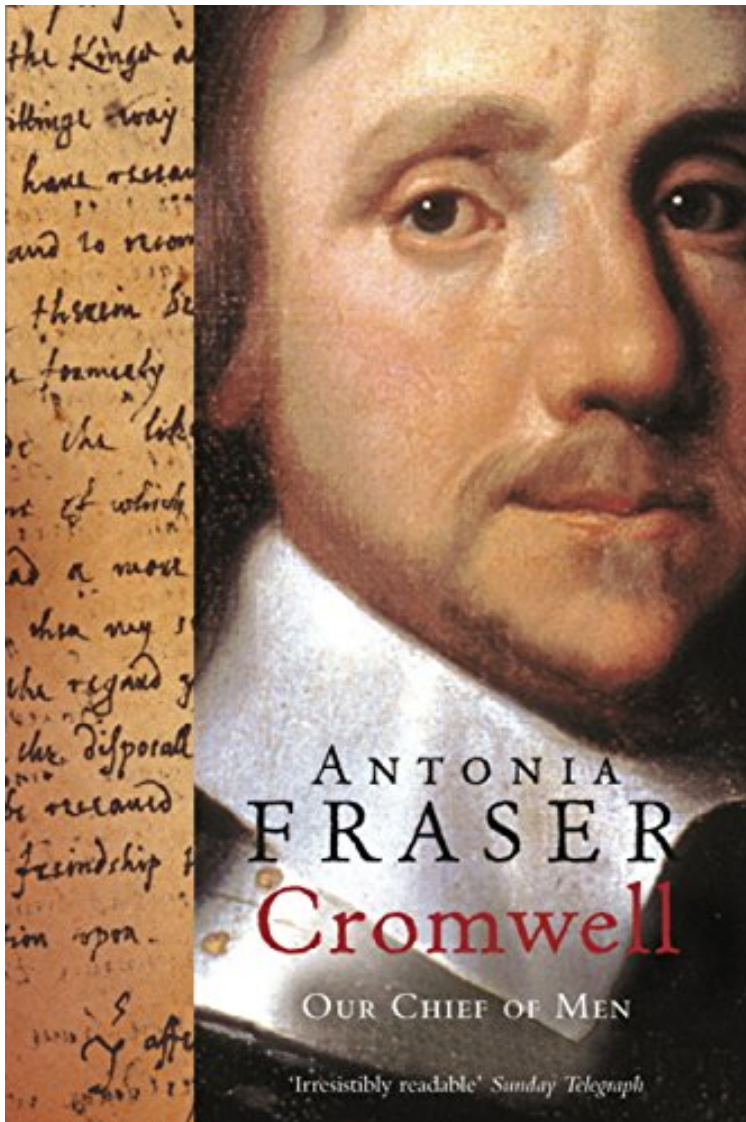

She has written five highly praised books which focus on women in history, *THE WEAKER VESSEL: WOMEN'S LOT IN SEVENTEENTH CENTURY ENGLAND* (Wolfson Award for History, 1984), *THE WARRIOR QUEENS: BOADICEA'S CHARIOT, THE SIX WIVES OF HENRY VIII, MARIE ANTOINETTE: THE JOURNEY* (Franco-British Literary Prize 2001), which was made into a film by Sofia Coppola in 2006 and most recently *LOVE AND LOUIS XIV: THE WOMEN IN THE LIFE OF THE SUN KING*.
